There will be no verification of entry unless the tournament is filled in which case the bowlers will be notified. It is recommended that entries be mailed at least two weeks prior to the tournament date.

ELIGIBILITY: Junior Bowler must be a Certified Westchester County USBC Bowling Association Youth Member TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. FORMAT: **Handicap Division**: Teams will bowl 5 games across 10 lanes in the qualifying round. 85% of the difference in the team's average and 400 will be added to each game. 40% of the field will advance to the semi-final round and will bowl 3 Baker Style match games.* All totals will be carried forward from the qualifying round, and a 30 pin bonus will be added for each match play victory. Handicap for this route will be 85% of the difference in the team's average and 200. (For example adult average 186, junior average 126 = Team average 312. 312/2 = 156. 200-156 = 44 x 85% = 37). The top 5 teams at the end of the 8 games will then bowl in the stepladder finals. Handicap will be 85% of the difference in the team's averages in the finals. **Scratch Division:** Teams will bowl 5 games across 10 lanes in the qualifying round. 40% of the field will advance to the semi-final round and will bowl an additional 3 Baker Style match games.* All totals will be carried forward from the qualifying round, and a 30 pin bonus will be added for each match play victory. The top 5 teams at the end of the 8 games will then bowl in the stepladder finals.
- 2. The tournament will begin with the qualifying round at 10:30 AM. All teams should be ready to check in 45 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time. Teams not ready to check in 45 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time may lose their reserved spot in the tournament.
- 3. The entry fee for each tournament shall be \$75.00 pre-paid. Entry fee breakdown: \$55.00 bowling fees, \$10.00 trophy expense, and \$10.00 tournament expense. (Trophy expense returned 100%) NO ENTRY FEE CAN BE RETURNED. Walk-on fees will be added to prize fund.
- 4. Trophies will be awarded to the teams who finish 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in each division. A trophy will also be awarded for the highest scratch game (in the qualifying round) for the junior bowler in either the scratch or handicap division.
- 5. The tournament is limited in the number of entries that can be accommodated. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. No telephone reservations can be accepted. Teams whose entries are received after the tournament has been filled will be notified. Walk-on entries will be accepted if space permits.
- 6. All rules not specifically covered will be governed by USBC rules. The tournament director reserves all rights.
- 7. For adult participants: USBC rule 319E will apply to all participants; USBC Rule 319D will not apply; USBC Rule 319A will apply.
- 8. **Adult Entering Average Rules**: Adults entering shall use their current certified league average (minimum of 21 games) as of entering date, or last year's final book average, which ever is higher. If an adult has neither of the above qualifications, they may enter at scratch (200).
- 9. Special Format Rules: Adult must bowl first in the qualifying round. In the *semi-final rounds and in the step-ladder finals the adult will bowl the 1,2,5,7, & 9th frames; the junior will bowl the 2,4,6,8, & 10th frames. (Handicap division only: handicap will be half of the 85% of the difference of the teams' averages.)

2024-2025 JUNIOR BOWLING TOUR ENTERING AVERAGE RULE:

- 1. Juniors must enter at their highest USBC certified average in any junior league or their final WCJBT (minimum 12 games) from the 2023-2024 season:
- 2. Or their highest average in their current league (minimum 12 games);
- 3. Or their Westchester County Junior Bowling Tour current average based on 12 games for the 2024-2025 season (whichever is higher Please note re-rating rules).

2024-2025 JUNIOR BOWLING TOUR ENTERING AVERAGE RULE:

Bowlers who have bowled less than 12 games in the 2024-2025 WCJBT season will be re-rated according to the following procedure:

- (A) Bowlers with less than 5 games in WCJBT competition will not be re-rated.
- (B) Bowlers with 5 games, but less than 12 games in WCJBT competition will take the average of their entering average and their current WCJBT average. The result will be the bowlers' re-rated average, which will be used if it is higher than the bowlers' entering average.

EXAMPLE:	Entering Average	140
	Current WCJBT Average	160
	Total	300
	Bowler's Re-rated Average (300/2)	150

(C) Bowlers with 12 games or more in WCJBT competition will use their current WCJBT average or their entering average, whichever is higher.

NOTE: The Junior Bowling Tour Average Re-Rating is designed to keep all bowlers as competitive as possible. All bowlers are continuously re-rated that may be deemed necessary by the tournament director.

WESTCHESTER COUNTY JUNIOR BOWLING TOUR POINT SYSTEM

Point standings for all bowlers who compete in the WCJBT will be computed, with points being awarded for the following position finished:

1st - 50	5th – 25	9th – 21	13th – 17	17th - 13	21st - 9
2nd - 40	6th – 24	10th - 20	14th – 16	18th – 12	22nd - 8
3rd – 35	7th - 23	11th – 19	15th – 15	19th – 11	23rd - 6
4th - 30	8th - 22	12th - 18	16th - 14	20th - 10	24th – 4

Bowlers who do not finish in the top 24 will receive 2 points for participation. A bowler who competes in all scheduled tournaments will receive an additional 10 points. The top 5 point scores at the completion of WCJBT season, in each division, will receive special awards at the Westchester County USBC Bowling Association Luncheon in June. Scholarships will also be awarded to at least the point champions in each division. Amounts of scholarships to be determined by funds raised during the season.

* Baker Style Match Games: Doubles, Each team member bowls five frames, alternating turns. The first bowler completes all odd-numbered frames, and the second bowler handles even-numbered frames.
